



FAQ'S

When are you opening this fall?

Our first day of school will be September 7. We are accepting up to 10 two-year-olds and up to 12 each in classes for three- and four-year-olds.

We are also continuing our summer camp for children who will be 2-years-old by October 1, 2022 through those entering kindergarten in fall 2022.

What will drop-off look like?

Families complete a health questionnaire each morning on the Remini app. Since visitors are not permitted in the school, students will be met at the door by the director to have their temperature taken with an infrared thermometer. They will then enter school to be met by their class teacher.

Will the COVID-19 protocols continue next year?

We will follow all state guidelines for the health and safety of our preschool community. As of now, we anticipate maintaining our current practices into the summer and possibly into fall as well.

Will children be required to wear masks all day?

Currently, everyone in the school - staff and students - are wearing masks both inside and outside. Fun printed disposable child-size masks are available at the school. We continue to monitor the changing situation and adjust our protocols accordingly.

We have never seen the school or the building - how can we get our child ready for school?

We will be happy to take you on a virtual tour of the school, and/or an in-person tour when children are not in attendance. We also connect teachers and students via technology to get to know each other before the first day..

How will lunch and snack work?

All children will bring their own lunch food in their own containers from home each day. Teachers will assist as needed, being sure to wear gloves. There will be no sharing of food.

What if someone tests positive for COVID-19?

We are required to follow the NJ DCF procedures as explained in [this document](#). We are relying on all of our families to help keep one another safe by honest, accurate reporting of their own health.
